



Online Scout Resource -Challenges

Challenge Name	Tied Up
Number of People/Teams	Teams of 4-12 people
Equipment Needed	Shoe Laces/Piece of Cloth/Rope (Anything which can tie the participants' wrists together)
Instructions	Organise your group into an inward facing circle. Ask them to hold out their arms to the side and then tie them to both of their neighbor's wrists. The whole group should now be connected and tied up. Next present a simple task for them to complete. Example: Wrap a present, build a bridge, make a lasso and try capturing a leader, tidy up the room, create an art project, pour a cup of water for everyone in the group
Other Notes	This can be done with ankles instead of wrists. To make it a tougher challenge, blindfold or mute a few of the participants.
