Role:

The Communications Officer is responsible for crafting and delivering effective communication strategies on behalf of the Maltese Scout Contingent. Working closely with the Head of Contingent, Unit Support Coordinator, and other leadership roles, this position ensures that key messages, updates, and stories from the contingent are shared accurately, engagingly, and in a timely manner to both internal and external audiences.

The Communications Officer plays a vital role in showcasing the Maltese Scout Contingent's journey and accomplishments at the World Scout Jamboree. By developing impactful messages, managing media relations, and maintaining consistent internal communications, this role ensures that every stakeholder—from Scouts and leaders to media and the wider community—receives accurate and engaging updates. Strong writing abilities, digital fluency, and a knack for storytelling are essential to excel in this position. While direct communications experience in a scouting context is preferred, the ideal candidate is a proactive communicator who can work effectively under pressure, adapt to changing circumstances, and uphold the values of Scouting at all times.







Skills Required:

An applicant for this role should have:

- Strong command of English and Maltese, with the ability to craft clear, engaging messaging.
- Competency in creating a variety of content forms, from press releases to social media updates.
- Proficiency in social media platforms (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, etc.), including analytics and community management.
- Basic graphic design or multimedia editing skills (e.g., Canva, Adobe Creative Suite, or similar tools) are advantageous.
- Capacity to develop and execute communications plans that align with broader contingent goals.
- Excellent organisational skills to prioritise information and respond swiftly to urgent situations.
- Familiarity with relevant World Scouting policies and guidelines.
- Prior experience in communications, public relations, or a similar role within a major Scouting event or large-scale youth event is strongly preferred.
