

BYE-LAW 4

Communication

Approved by National Scout Council on the 27 September 2025

1. The official languages of The Scout Association are Maltese and English.
In the event of a conflict arising out of the interpretation of the Constitution, its Bye-Laws or any other official document of The Scout Association, the English text shall prevail.
2. Any reference to the Association's journal in the Constitution or elsewhere in official documents of the Association shall be deemed to refer to the Association's official website.
3. All official communications, notices, and publications required by the Constitution, its Bye-Laws or any other official document of the Association shall be deemed duly delivered when sent by email to the addresses of the members of the General Assembly as recorded in the Association's official database.
