Update on the upcoming Introduction of New Scout Uniform

Dear Leaders and Members,

This communication is being issued in order to ensure that comprehensive information about the adoption of a new scout uniform reaches all stakeholders.

We are finally drawing towards the conclusion of a process which will provide us with a uniform that is functional and will present a better image of contemporary Scouting in line with WOSM guidelines.

1) Uniform procurement process

A procurement process has been undertaken by the Association with the gathering of quotes from various local and international suppliers occurring as from November, 2015.

Following detailed comparisons, a supplier has been selected and negotiations are now finalised. We are currently awaiting actual final samples to ensure quality and delivery of specifications before entering into an agreement with a supplier by the end of the week.

The size information requested from all groups recently is required so that the production of the uniform is done in one large batch which would ensure final price and avoid excessive over-stocking.

The Groups who have yet to submit the 'Indicative Order Form' are therefore required to submit this **URGENTLY**. For an indicative price list *refer to '7 - Buying the Uniform' hereunder*).

It is envisaged that with everyone's cooperation, the new uniform will first be available for purchase from supplier as from August, 2016.

2) New Scout Uniform items

On page 5 please find, in detailed tabular format, the new scout uniform items depending on age group/section (Adult Leaders / Rovers / Ventures / Scouts / Cubs / Beavers) and split by gender (Male / Female). Individual adult members/leaders (+18) are to select which type of bottom garment they are to wear from the table provided. (cont./2)

Note: There is no headgear with the new uniform.

3) New Group Name Tags

Group Name Tags were designed afresh for each Group so as to maintain a 'uniform' look since in the old uniform, these varied in size, shape and colour. These new Group Name Tags will be available for sale from IHQ.

4) Old Scout Uniform and any variations

The complete uniform as defined above is the only official uniform for ALL leaders and members. All variations found in the old uniform are no longer permitted. Furthermore please note that:

- Only commemorative badges approved by Executive Committee can be worn on the new uniform shirt.
- The current respective group scarves, woggles and scout belt are to be retained.
- Footwear is to be Black Shoes or Hiking Shoes where appropriate.
- Members will wear epaulettes in their respective section colours.
- Leaders epaulettes will remain as in current use.

It is also important to note that any Group Activity Wear which does not conform to the Branding Document is also no longer permitted. Activity wear for Leaders should be in Red or light Grey, whilst that of members should be in Orange, Green or Blue (including one of the 6 approved designs on the T-shirts). Activity wear also includes the approved cap with the logo "Scouts Nibnu Dinja Ahjar" on it, no other caps are permitted. Any groups who have not adopted the official activity wear should do so without further delay.

5) Application for Scout Uniform Accessories

In order to preserve the scout band heritage which has developed over the years (such as kilts, lanyards and other accessories currently worn by bands) and balance this with the needs of contemporary Scouting (including apparel required for religious reasons), the Executive Committee will appoint a 'Board of Review' to receive 'Applications for Scout Uniform Accessories' from Scout Groups wishing to make such a request. More information on this process will be provided by June 2016.

6) Transition Period

There will be a period of transition which will end on the 31st of December 2017 in which all members of the Association are to effect the switch from the old to the new uniform.

As from the 1st of January 2018, the new scout uniform will be the only authorised wear for ALL youth members and adult leaders making up the Scout Association of Malta.

It is to be noted that the supply of the uniform can be delayed due to the fact that some Groups have not yet forwarded their 'Indicative Order Form' returns.

Therefore the cooperation of Groups who have not yet submitted their information as instructed is urgently solicited in order to speed up the process.

7) Buying the uniform

The items will be available for purchase from the supplier's shop which will be open during normal shop hours from Monday to Saturday.

The current arrangements for the purchase of badges from Island Headquarters will be retained until further notice.

Adults and youth members who require a) oversize garments (made-to-measure) or b) approved different cuts due to religious purposes, will have a facility to make an appointment with the supplier for sizing. The cost of the garment will be same as for regular sizes.
