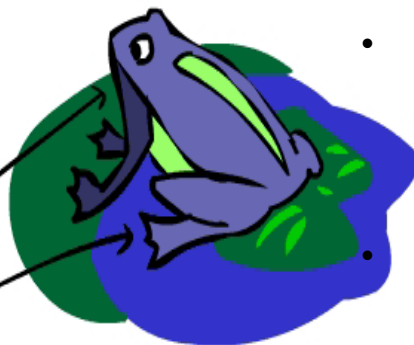

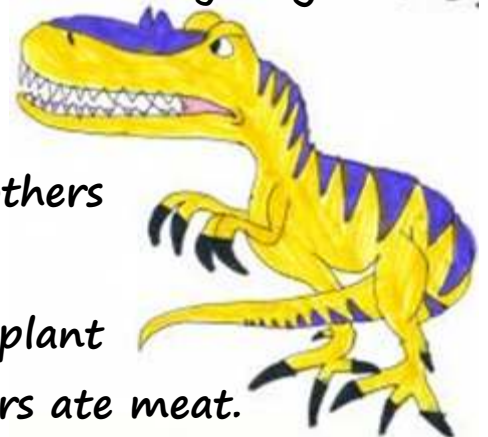

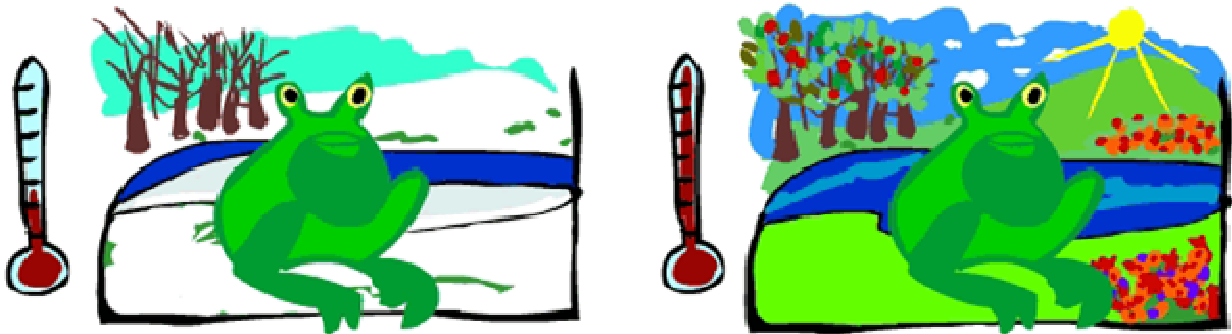


COLD BLOODED

Cold-blooded animals, like reptiles, amphibians, and fish, become hotter and colder, depending on the temperature outside.

For example, when the sun sets at night, their bodies are cooler because it is less warm outside. When the sun is out, however, their bodies soak up the heat and become warmer.

Cold-blooded ANIMALS

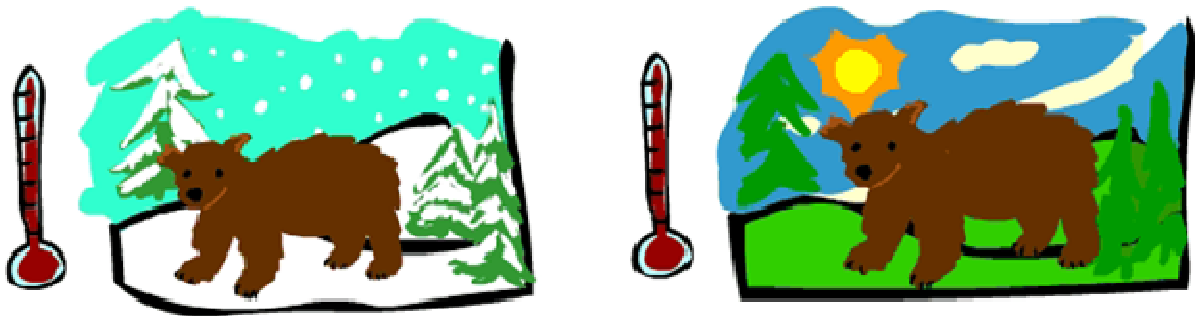


Body temperature depends on whether it's cold or hot outside.

WARM BLOODED

Mammals and birds are warm-blooded, which means that they can make their own body heat no matter the external climatic conditions. Infact warm-blooded animals have body temperatures that usually stay the same.

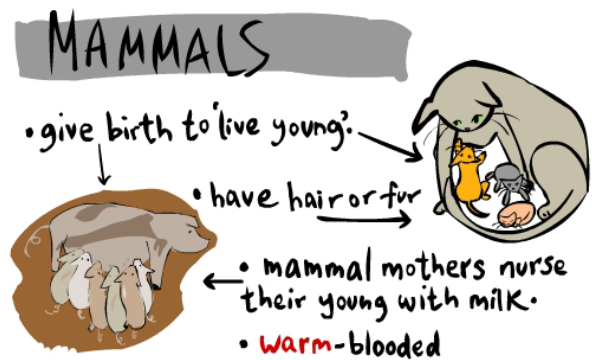

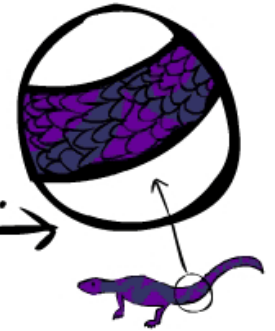


Chameleon

Dinosaurs

Dinosaurs were a special kind of creature that lived a very very long time ago. Scientists do not actually know the cause of extinction but they have many theories; such as volcanic eruptions, and climate changes over a long period of time. Dinosaurs were around for millions of years. During that time they evolved and adapted to suit their environment and conditions.

There were many different types of Dinosaurs :

- Some were plant eaters (herbivores), others meat eaters (carnivores) and some ate both plants and meat (omnivores).
- There were scavenger dinosaurs
- Some dinosaurs were armoured with horns, thorns, and spikes.
- Some had very long necks.
- Some dinosaurs had wings and could fly.
- Some had sharp teeth whilst others had flat teeth.

Giganotosaurus was the biggest dinosaur!



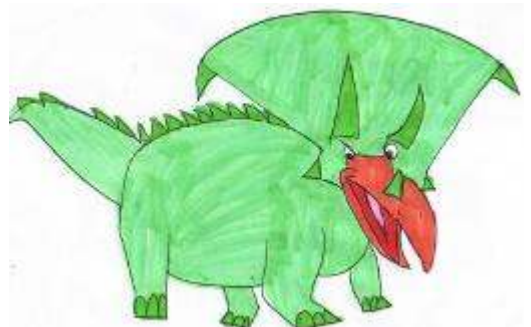
Deinonychus had twice as many teeth on the bottom as on the top!

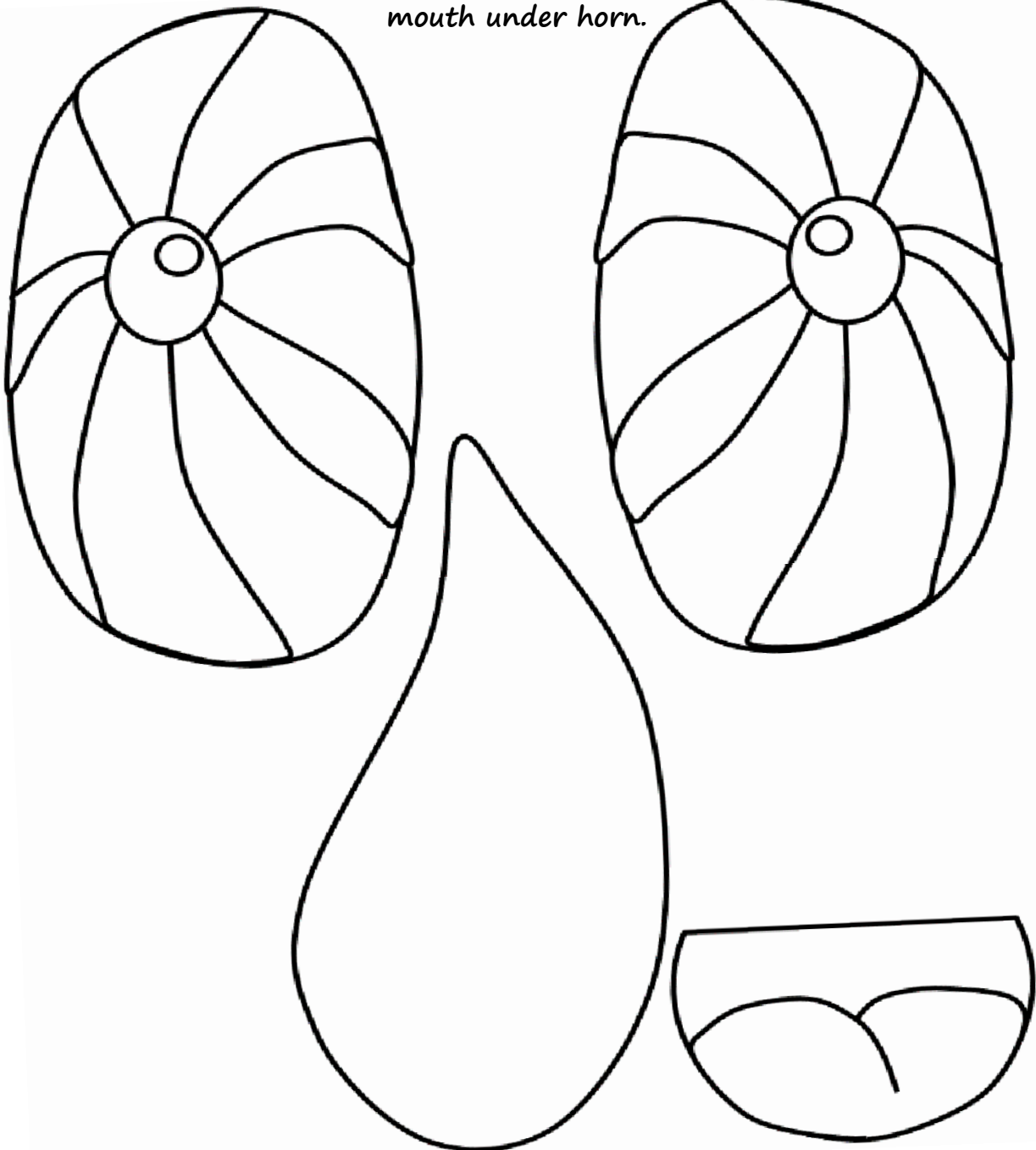


Chameleon Paper Plate Craft

- Fill the box with whatever you like!!





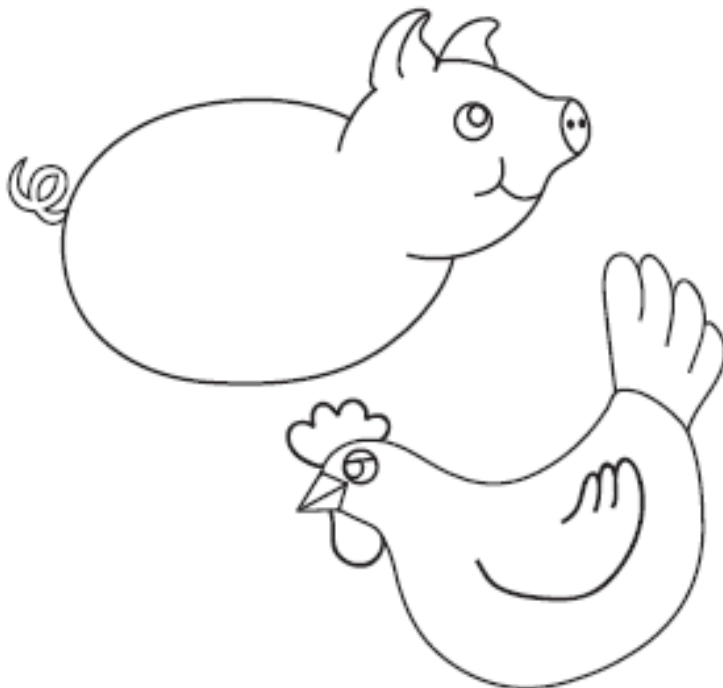

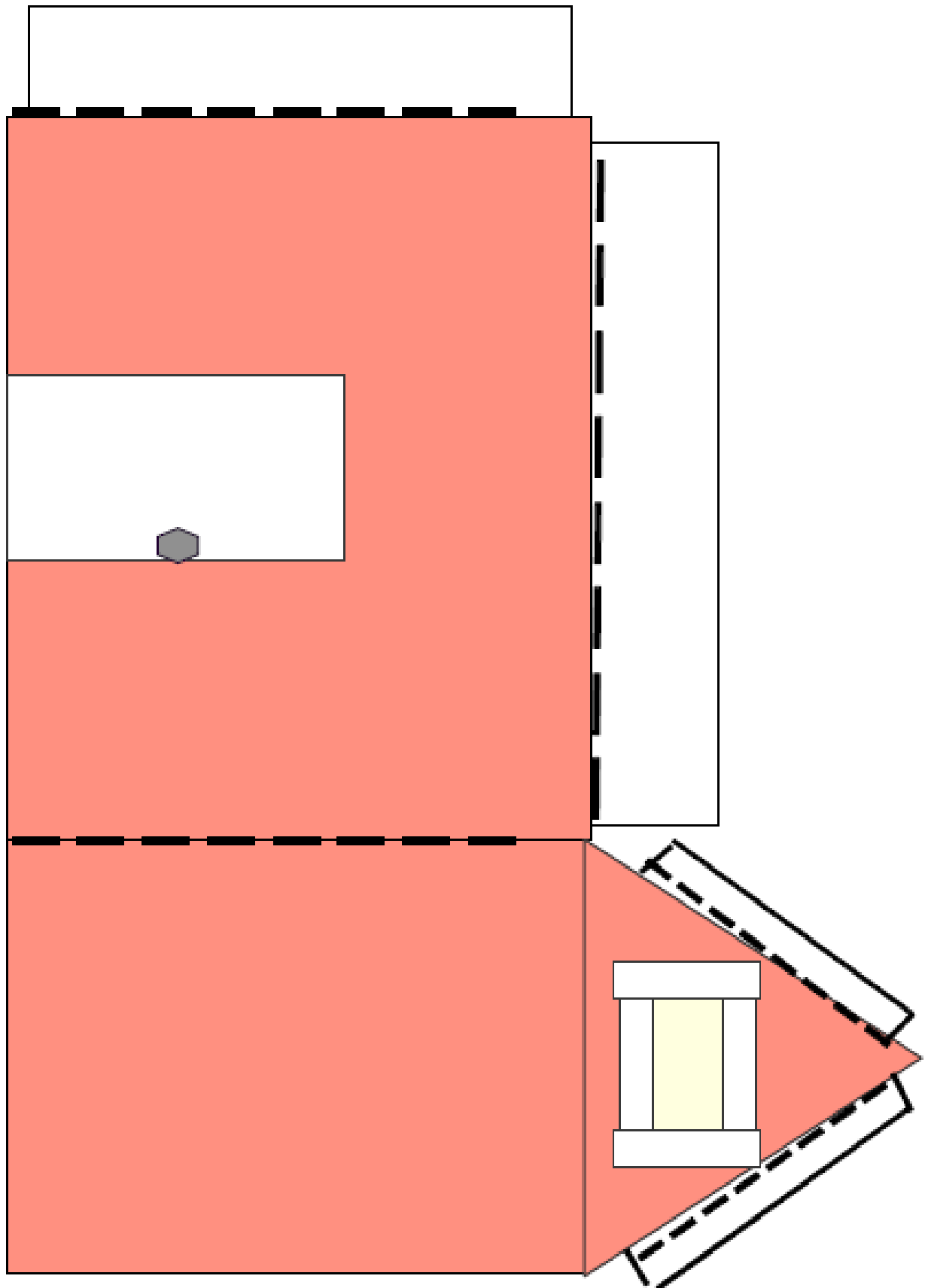

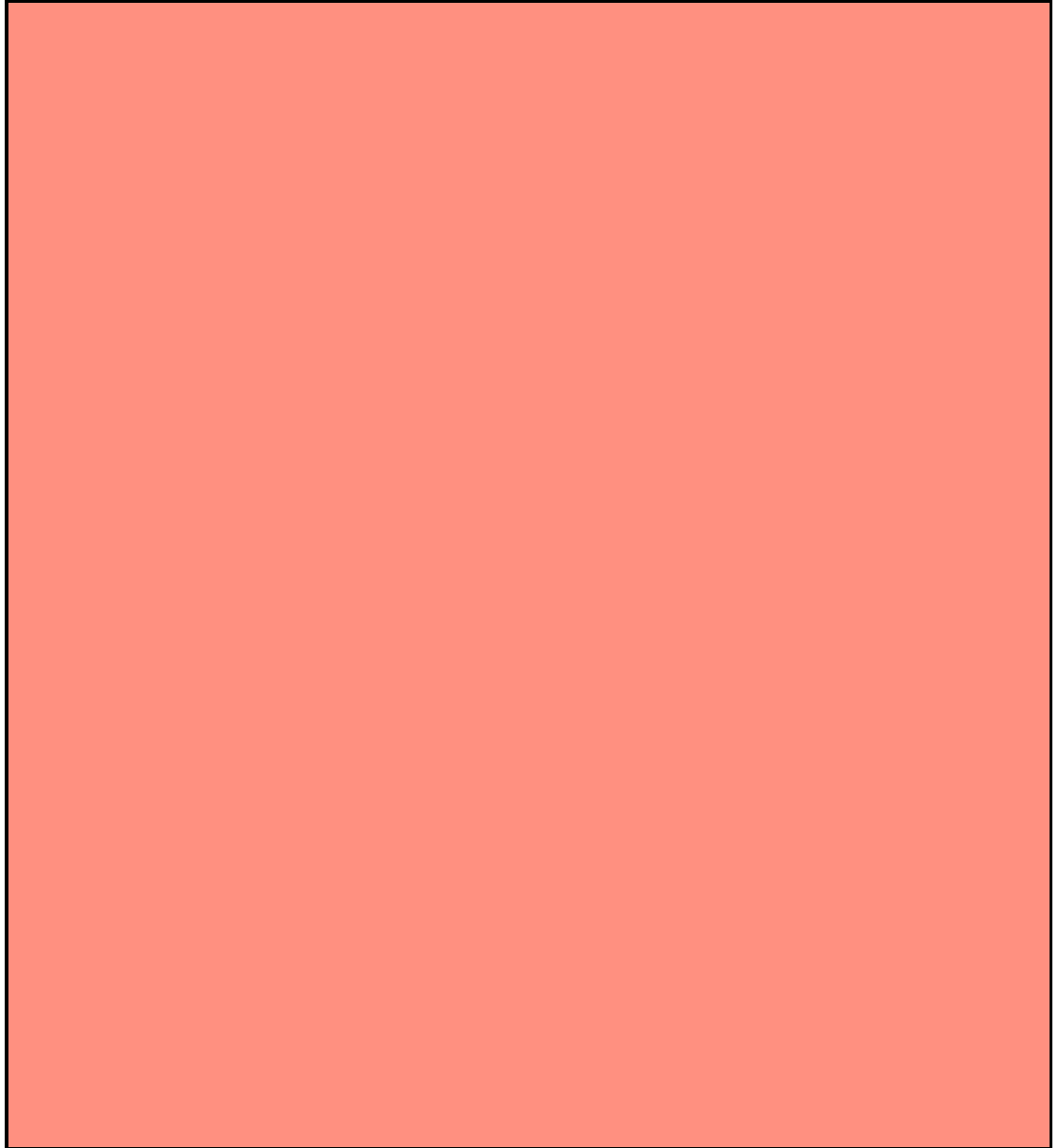
- Print out and glue the farm animals template on and a cardboard paper.
