# God is your friend Bead a Cross What you will need: Beads



2. Before you start stringing, you will need to attach 3 beads together with glue.





6. Take your top bead and lace

both ends of the string through it. Tie a knot at the top of the beads to hold the cross in place. Pull tight and you have your cross necklace!!

- Scissors


#### How to do it:

1. Start by laying out 6 coloured




#### Log Chew

However it is nice to walk in God's path and try to set a good example.




Sometimes we don't always set a good example and we can bother other people by;








This is a very simple craft.

All you need to do is colour and cut out the template given. Thread 2 antennae in the head and you're done.








God saw that the people on His earth were mean.






## Glittery Jesus Fish

Take a toilet paper roll and flatten it.

Then cut it into strips. Cut the ring apart at one fold, cut 2 slits, and fit it together in the shape of Jesus fish.







It would be fun to just paint them, but its even nicer with glitters. To do this, use a paint brush to put some white glue onto the toilet paper roll.

Once its all covered in glue, it's time to add the glitter over the top of the fish. Shake the glitter over the top of the fish and voila' you are ready....



You can also use this craft as a game.

Just attach a paper clip to the fish. Use a dowel and tie a thread with a magnet attached to it. Give it a go at fishing!!




How to do it:


- About 14 toilet paper rolls or cardboard squares

- Staples/Tape





#### How to do it:




You can also print the templates and stick them on cardboard, colour, cut and use tape or staples to make them into a cylinder.










