Making a Totem Pole



Akela meets the Colony

Step 1: INTRODUCE

Akela and Pack Leaders to visit your Colony during a meeting or activity. They get to talk to your Beavers and familiarize with them.

Step 2: FAMILIARIZE

Involve these leaders during the meeting/activity in a game or craft that would be running at that time. Pair a Beaver or more Beavers with each Leader. This will help the Beaver/s to 'make friends' with the Leader.

Step 3: RECIPROCATE

You as BSL, should do the same and visit the Pack. Familiarize with the Pack.

Step 4: THE ACTIVITY

Since the Pack Leaders have met the Beavers and you have met the Cubs, it will be easier for all the Beavers/Cubs to get closer to all Leaders. This will help towards the safe running of the activity.

Step 5: POST MORTEM

Carry out a post mortem between the Leaders of the Sections to discuss the activity and sort out any finance issues.

Also carry out a Log Chew with the Beavers in your own Colony and get their own opinion about the activity. This will give you a good idea of what to look out for in the following activity.



Making a Totem Pole

What you will need:

- Large Cardboard Roll
- Scotch Tape
- Poster Paint
- Paint Brushes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Print-outs of animals of your choice to place on the totem (*look at the totem picture below for suggestions*)
- Apron
- Varnish

How to do it:

- Print the pictures that you have chosen.
- Cut them all out.
- Carefully stick them with glue to the cardboard roll, one next to the other and let them dry thoroughly for at least a day or two.
- Paint all the images with bright coloured poster colours.
- Let it dry for another day or two. The paint has to be totally dry in order to carry out the next step.
- When it is thoroughly dry apply a good layer of varnish. This will protect the paint from chipping.
