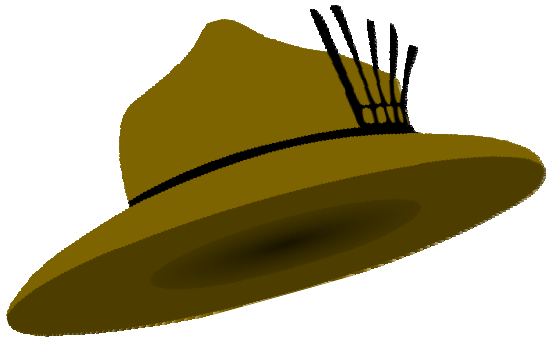

Elegant Place Mats

Make your Scouting Dinner elegant with these simple patterned blue and gold place mats. Colours can be personalized depending on the particular celebration

What you'll need:

- Blue and yellow A4 cardboard paper
- Fleur-de-lys hole punch
- Ruler
- Pencil and Pen
- Scissors
- Zig Zag Scissors
- Glue

How to make them:

- In each of the corners of the blue cardboard paper, punch a fleur-de-lys [see the photo]
- Cut 4 yellow cardboard paper squares.
- They are to be glued at the back of each fleur-de-lys design to make it stand out.
- Cut a strip of yellow cardboard paper about 3" x 8"
- Using the zigzag scissors, cut around the yellow cardboard paper
- Have the Scout write his name [or for whom the mat is intended], in his handwriting.
- Glue the sheet with the name in the middle of the blue one.

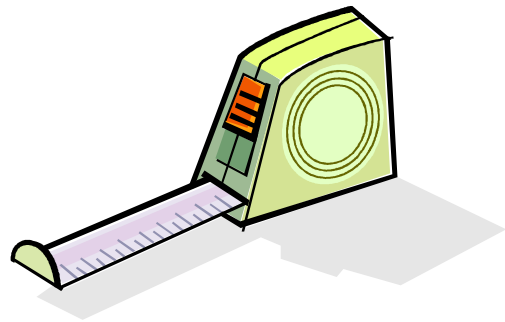


Scout Tool Box

Build and decorate your own scout toolbox. You will need the help of your Beaver Scout Leader or of an adult to carry out this project.

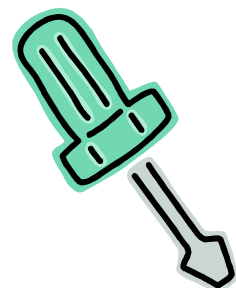
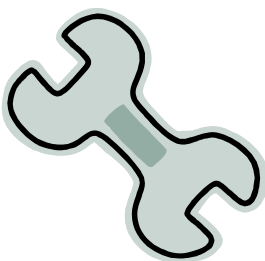
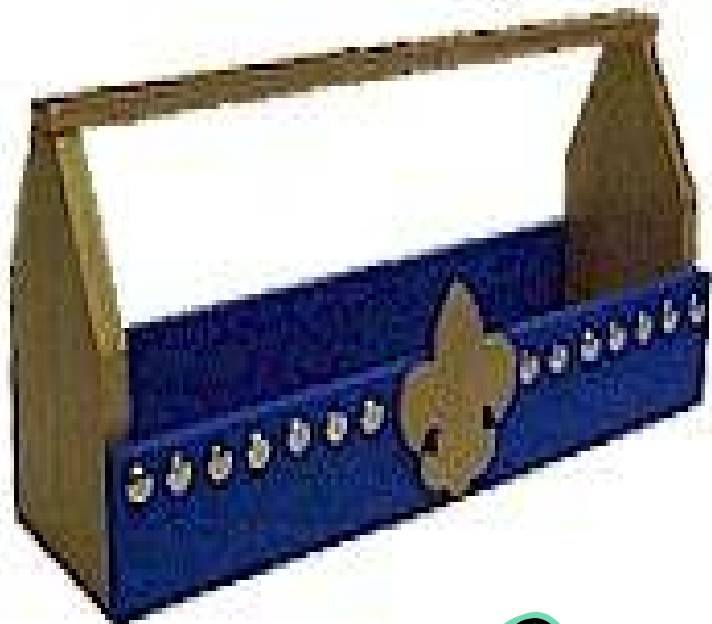
What you'll need:

- Old Toolbox
- Wood Glue
- Medium Fleur de Lys shape cut out of wood
- Blue & Gold Paint
- Sand Paper
- Gold Thumb Tacks
- Mallet



How to make them:

- Using the Sand Paper to sand the toolbox down to remove rough edges.
- Paint the long sides blue and the short sides and handle gold.
- Let them dry thoroughly.
- Paint the wooden fleur-de-lys gold.
- Glue it in the middle of one of the blue sides. [You can have a fleur de lys on each of the blue sides].
- Place gold tacks into the blue sides to decorate [see picture]
- Bang flush with mallet.



Drinking Straws Woggle

Got some drinking straws and don't know what to do with them?? Well here is a creative way how to use them. Please ask your BSL to help you with this project.

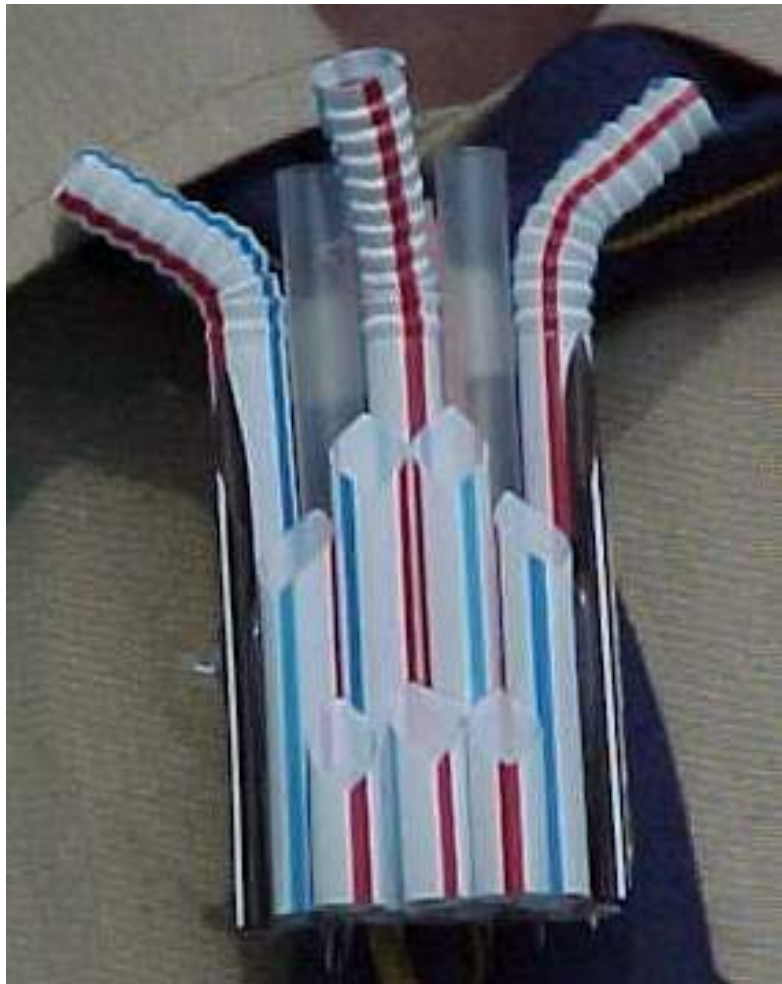


What you'll need

- Plastic Straws – Colours of your choice –
for example: the Colour of your Group's Scarf or the Colours of Country Flag
- Plastic ring the size of a Woggle
- Hot Glue Gun & Glue Refills (*to be handled by an adult only*)
- Scissors

How to make it:

- Cut the straws to various lengths as shown in the picture below.
- With the help of your Leader or of an adult, glue together the cut out straws with the hot glue gun onto the plastic ring
- Leave to dry thoroughly over night.

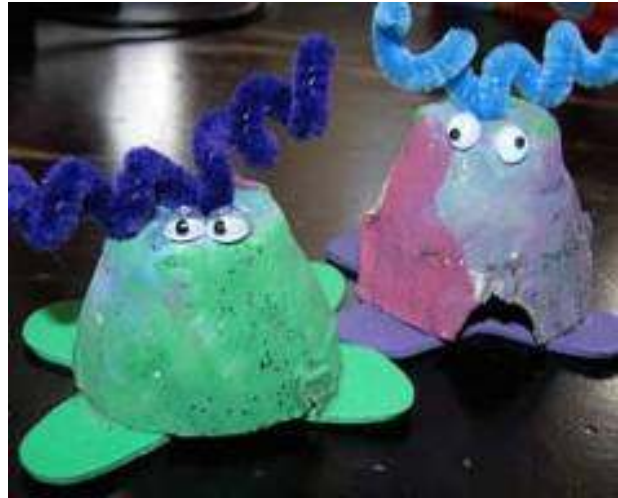


Egg Carton Critters

Recycle those old egg cartons into fun critters. There is no wrong way to make these wacky guys.

What you'll need:

- Egg carton
- Acrylic paint and brushes
- Glue
- Assorted embellishments googly eyes, beads, buttons, pipe cleaners, glitter glue



How to make it:

- Cut the shapes from the egg carton as shown in the small picture here.
- Paint the shapes and let them dry thoroughly overnight
- Stick the eyes
- Decorate with glitter glue, beads, pipe cleaners, etc.



Cool Glass Jars

Your Glass Jars at home look boring. Well here is a very simple way how to jazz them up a bit!

What you'll need:

- Glass or Plastic Jars
- Strong glue
- Googly Eyes (assorted sizes)
- Buttons of assorted sizes and colours
- Assorted items for decorating: beads, pipe cleaners, glitter glue, pompoms, foamy stickers, plastic figurines, pipe cleaner, etc.

How to make it:

- Clean the jars thoroughly with warm water and soap
- Decorate the jar.

WARNING: BSL to be extra careful when doing this craft. Since the children are dealing with glass it is important to have the children supervised at all times.
