ANIMATION

The concepts of Animation should be done in a practical session with the cubs, first help them decide what to do/choose a song, then let them do it (guide them throughout the activity), due to their age help may be required (some may forget their exact role).

The cubs have to take an active part in this section. They need to choose one of the following to perform during a campfire or at pack meetings, and discuss with you as a leader for approval.

- o Sing an action song
- o Present a Mime
- o Form an Orchestra with the aid of their friends
- o Produce a puppet show together with the six and then give a performance in front of the pack or during the campfire

Activity: Pack Meeting/ Campfire



Objective: Act infront of a group of people



Time: 1-2 weeks



Outline: The main aim of this activity is that the cubs start giving the cubs some time to gain self confidence. Some might find it easy while others hard to express themselves. It is important that as leaders we help out as much as possible especially those who lack it.



Equipment: Depending what equipment you need for that particular act.

ACTIVITY FACT SHEET



During the Activity:



– The cubs have different roles while learning to work in a team in order to give a good general performance.



– This depends on the particular act that is going to be performed. It can vary from lifting and moving props in preparation of the animation, to the physical activity during the act itself.



– The cub needs to prepare and learn the act. Animation enables the cub to show his/her talent, move away from shyness and helps in public speaking.



– Animation gives leeway to the cubs in expressing their creativity. Cubs are given the opportunity to express their ideas on how to perform the act. Leader must always be present during this activity to make sure the act is done safely.



-During these sessions different emotions play a major role. This is because cubs will have different acts/parts/characters/songs to perform. Processing the emotions that come out during the particular act, helps the cubs in becoming more emotionally aware.
