### **ANIMATION**

Basically, a cub can be good in handcrafts but not in animation or communication. So, the purpose of this session is to challenge the cub and urge him/her to test oneself and try to make things which they are shy to do or even worse, think they are not capable of doing. In this section the Cubs are required to take an active part in one of the following. As they are bigger and more mature they need to perform during a campfire or at pack meetings.

- o Set up an interview about a topic you enjoy. You may record it on video. Discuss the subject beforehand with your leader. Then present your work to your leader.
- Organise a performance and animate in front of an audience. You must include a preplanned program giving details of your animation (e.g. Sports games, sea side activity, mini campfire etc)

#### **Suggestions:**

o Let the cubs that are doing the gold arrow take active part in the campfire by preparing for the stunts, presenting the campfire. A talent night can also be organised where the cubs will perform either as a group or individual in front of their parents.

– Some will get jealous towards each other as others are performing better than they are, they will feel different emotions while taking part in the stunt and presenting the campfire - happy, anxious, excited. Help them through these emotions, and remind them to do THEIR best.



– At the end of the campfire they pray to God through kum-baya.
