## Profile

Investigate two subjects which affect our body and mind such as smoking, drugs, diet, sleep requirements, personal hygiene and skin care. Present your findings to your Unit or the VSL and discuss.

20 POINTS

Organise a series of activities for your Unit on a values theme.

20 POINTS

Plan, organise and present the Scout's Own Service at a camp.

15 POINTS

Organise an activity for persons outside scouting suffering from an integration/diversity issue.

30 POINTS

Take an active part in a project examining your own faith such as a retreat.

20 POINTS

15 POINTS

Save a couple of lives by donating some blood. Organise a blood donating event for your unit and group leaders.

Identify a weak point in your character and devise a plan/means of how to develop it.

15 POINTS

Take part in Spiritual activities within your community.

15 POINTS

Talk with the Cub Scout Leader and carry out the spirituality session to the cubs in either the Bronze, Silver or Gold Arrow.
